Only the top half of a rainbow is visible from the horizon. To see its complete loop, one must ascend to a higher vantage point! That is exactly the view Noah had atop the mountains of Ararat. Just as the unending circle of a wedding band symbolizes the covenant of marriage, so also the circle rainbow symbolizes God's covenant to man to never again destroy the earth with water. Every **Major Key** has a **Relative Minor Key**. This song teaches its sound by switching **3 - 2 - 1 - (7) - (6)** to **5 - 4 - 3 - 2 - 1**.

When we lift our voice in praise and worship to God, we not only use the very breath He gave us, we sing salvation's story. Rules of harmony state that **3** should never be doubled. Jesus said, "I AM the Way" - not, as many want to believe, a way. When **3** is bruised (an accidental lowers it) the sound is Parallel Minor. "*He was bruised for our iniquities.*" - Isaiah 53:5. This God-so-loved-the-world event happened "in the fulness of time" - expressed by the rhythmic "Tick-Tock" of a clock.
